(incl. benzodiazepines, antihistamines, psychotropics)

- Monitor serum magnesium & potassium
- Hydrate prior to surgery
- Avoid hepatotoxic anesthetic agents.
- Use with Caution Catecholamines, sympatho-mimetics, vasodilators, hypotensive agents with caution
