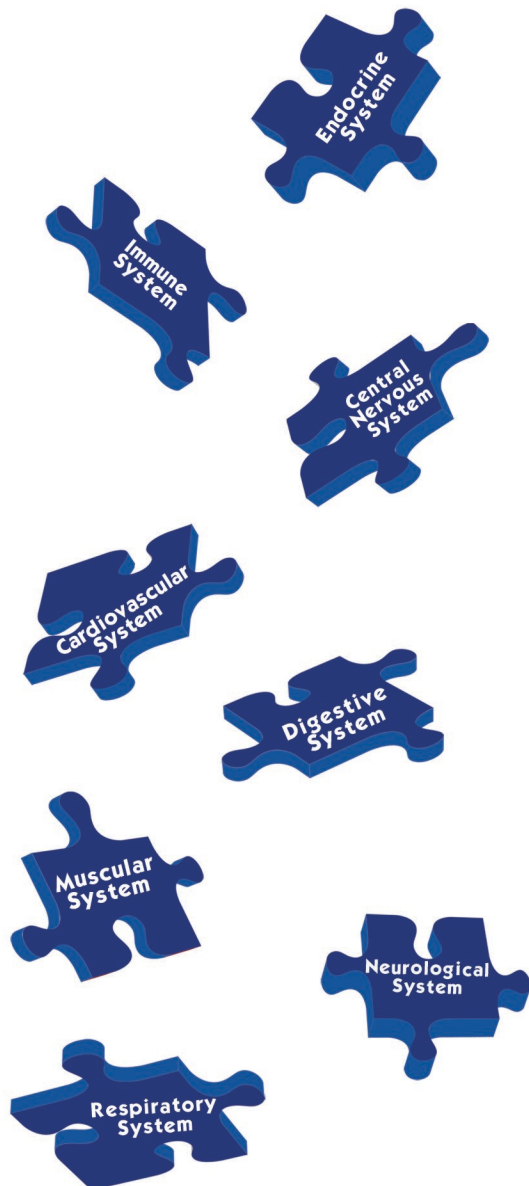

ME/CFS Putting the Pieces Together



Chronic Fatigue Syndrome (CFS) is a serious, complex and disabling disease, which causes incapacitating fatigue and a wide variety of immune, neurological, endocrine, cardiovascular and other symptoms. It substantially reduces the patient's ability to function. Symptoms are made worse by physical and mental activity and are not relieved by rest or sleep. Researchers hypothesize that factors such as exposure to infectious agents, environmental toxins, or physical trauma, as well as a genetic predisposition, interact to produce the illness.

At least one million American men, women, and children suffer from CFS. The disease is also known as Myalgic Encephalomyelitis (ME) or Chronic Fatigue and Immune Dysfunction Syndrome (CFIDS). The acronym ME/CFS is increasingly being used. Symptoms, which must be present for at least six months, include pathological fatigue and many of the following: post-exertional malaise, cognitive and neurological problems, sleep disorders, headaches, muscle or joint pain, tender lymph nodes in the neck and armpits, fever, sore throats and gastrointestinal problems. Before a diagnosis of ME/CFS is made, many other illnesses that also cause incapacitating fatigue must be excluded.
